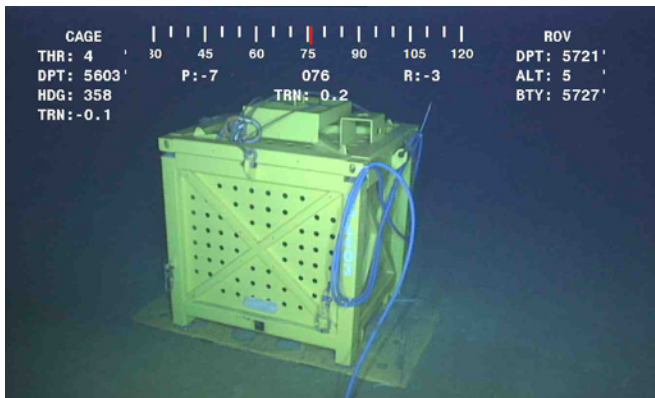


Subsea Reservoir

Pressure-compensated reservoir



The subsea reservoir is a pressure-compensated, DNV-certified system featuring a collapsible reservoir tank surrounded by a steel frame on a mudmat.

The system is capable of delivering and retrieving fluid and is commonly used with pumping skids and remediation systems for chemical injection of flowlines. It can also be used for recovery of stranded fluid inventory or as temporary storage for effluent from the hydrate remediation skid (HRS).
