

## Shipping Dangerous Goods

Transport of dangerous goods (hazardous materials) around the world is regulated through the United Nations Recommendation on the Transport of Dangerous Goods. Regulations may vary depending the mode of transportation – air, water, or ground; however, key requirements for every location remain the same.

- Employees that package, ship, or carry dangerous goods must be trained on their identification.
- Training must be specific to the job of working with dangerous goods.
- Employees must be trained in the job-specific emergency requirements for handling dangerous goods.
- Dangerous goods must be packaged according to the requirements of the mode of transportation, quantity, their hazards.
- Transport of dangerous goods may require shipping documentation specific to the mode of transportation.
- No employee shall transport dangerous goods in personal vehicles or luggage.
