### Before you travel

- Obtain specific pre-travel country risk assessments
- Clear personal data or information from your computer, smart phone and other digital devices. If you do not need the device, do not take it.
- Clear out your voicemail
- Make copies of your passport, airplane tickets, driver's license, and credit cards that you take with you. Leave a copy at home.
- Establish points of contact for emergencies.
- Obtain phone numbers and address for Embassies or Consulates in the country you plan to visit.
- Familiarize yourself with local laws and customs in the areas you plan to travel.
- Plan your wardrobe so that it does not offend residents or draw unwanted attention to yourself.
- Do not take unnecessary identification or credit cards.
